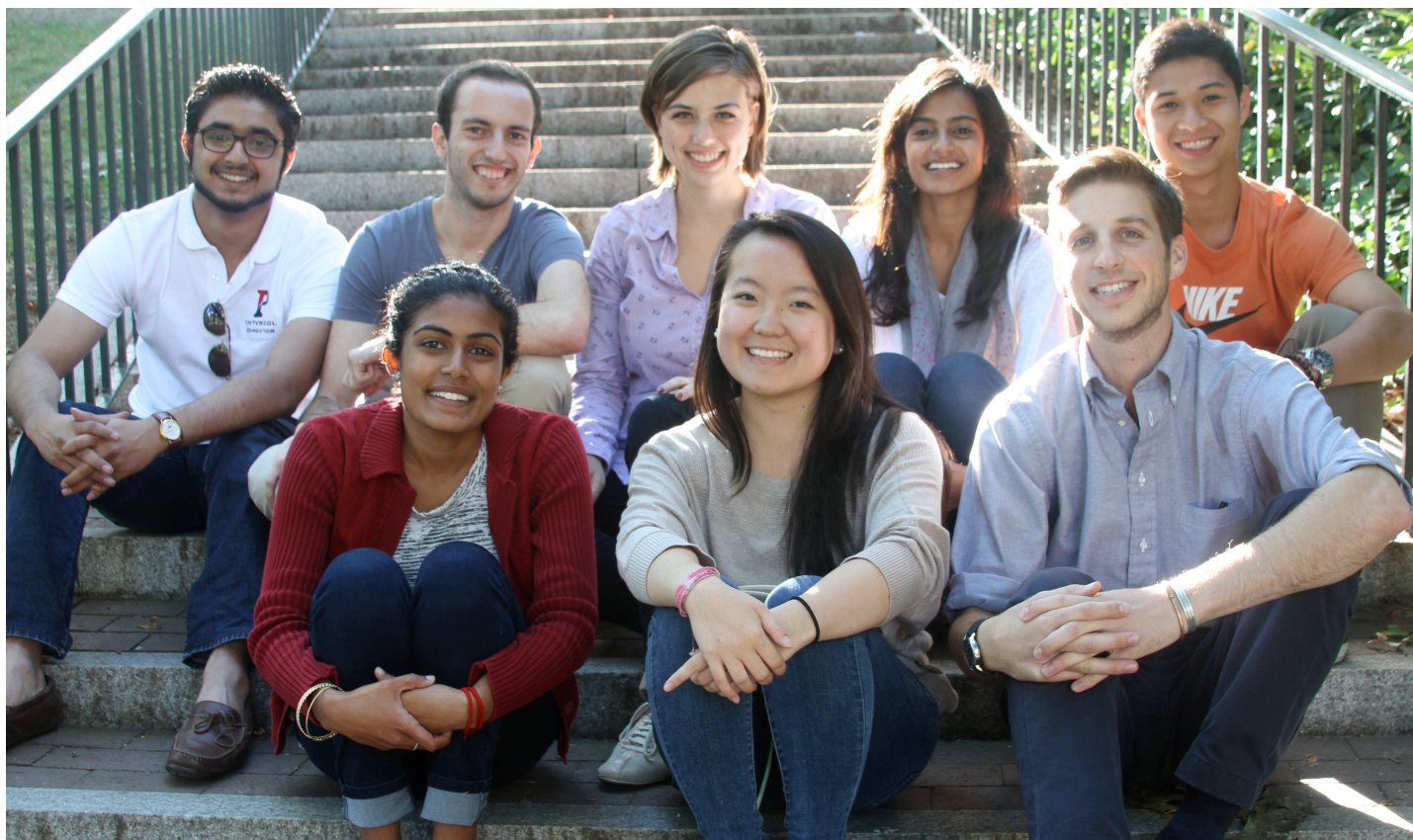


CASI Student Programs Symposium
