This experience aids the foundation in refining its strategies and expanding its impact. Ideal candidates have interests in rural research, water and agriculture development, women's empowerment, and communication.



Internship Details

- 10 week internship from May 2025 August 2025.
- CASI will provide one (1) Penn student approximately \$5,500 each to cover travel to and within India, affordable housing, and living expenses.
- Funds for the CASI Summer Internship are available through a combination of generous support from CASI donors and Penn Global
